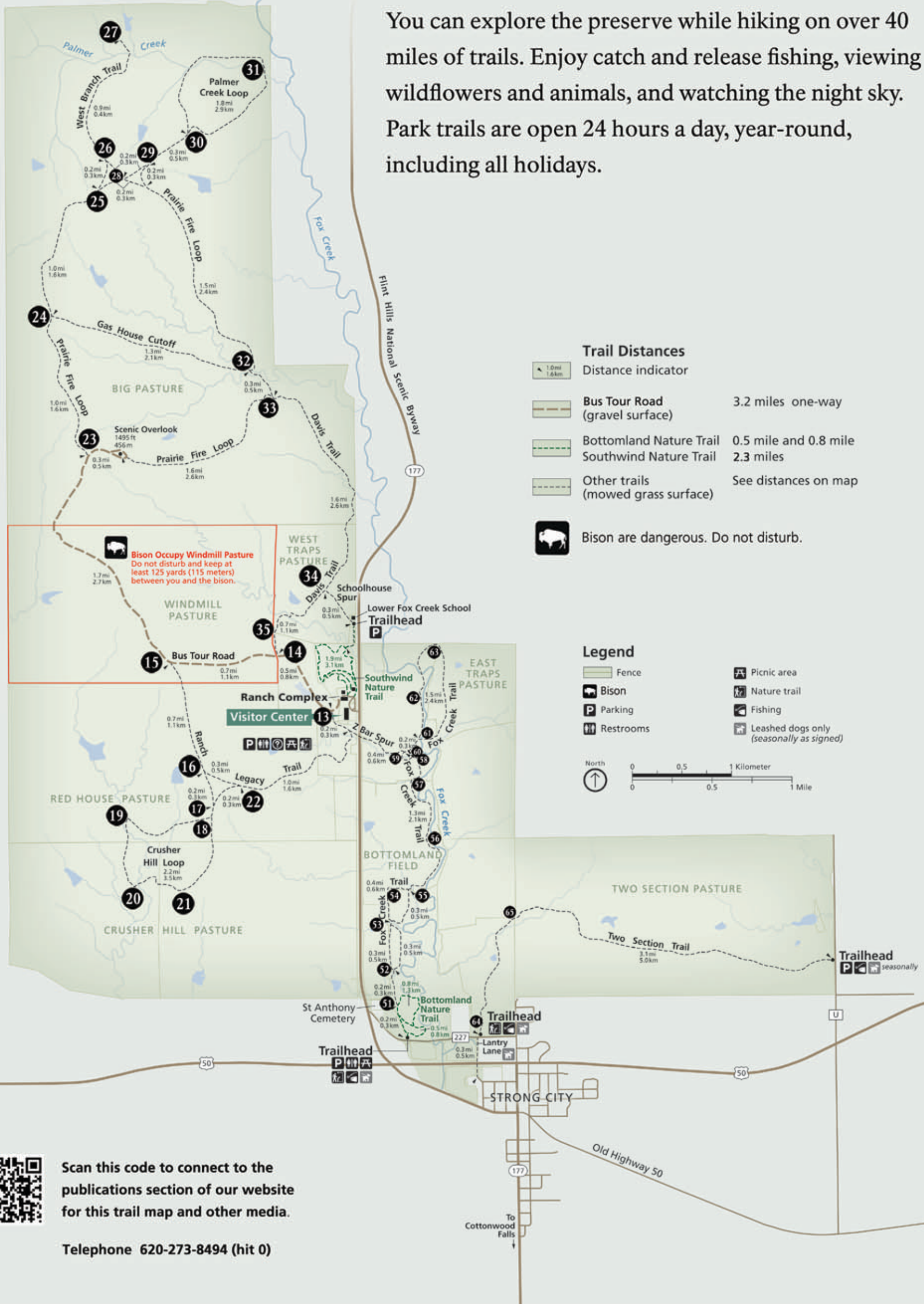




We extend our thanks to The Nature Conservancy for generously providing public access to their privately-owned land within the boundary of the Tallgrass Prairie National Preserve.

Tallgrass Prairie Trails

You can explore the preserve while hiking on over 40 miles of trails. Enjoy catch and release fishing, viewing wildflowers and animals, and watching the night sky. Park trails are open 24 hours a day, year-round, including all holidays.



Trail Distances

- Distance indicator
- Bus Tour Road (gravel surface) 3.2 miles one-way
- Bottomland Nature Trail 0.5 mile and 0.8 mile
- Southwind Nature Trail 2.3 miles
- Other trails (mowed grass surface) See distances on map
